

# EVERYTHING'S ROSIE LET'S MAKE ROSIE'S HAIR

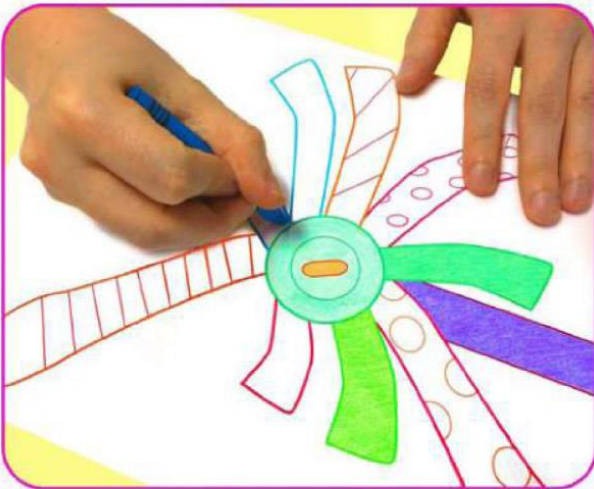


## You will need:

Safety Scissors  
Crayons, pens, pencils or felt tips  
Sticky tape



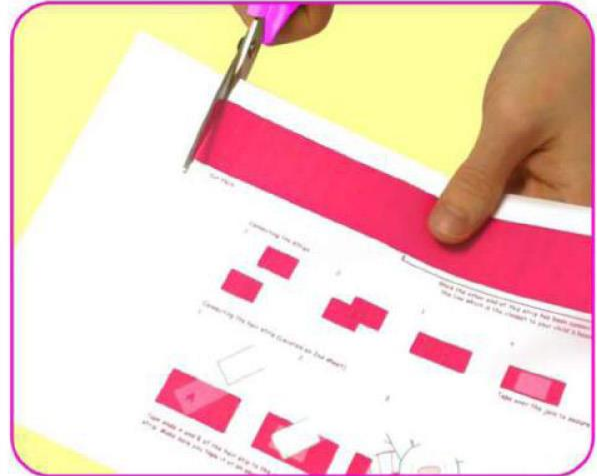
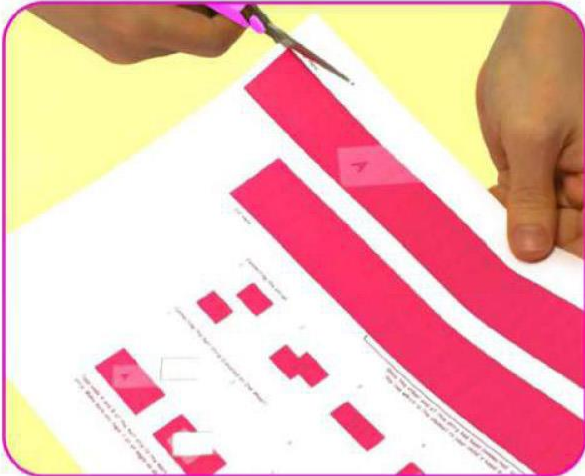
1. Colour in Rosie's Hair (Use your favourite colours!)



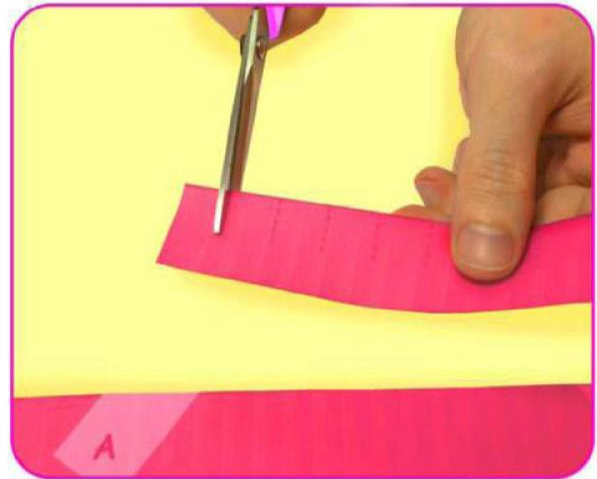
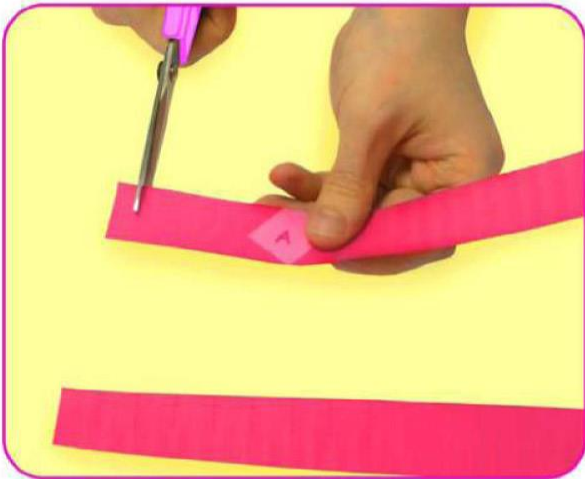
2. Cut out Rosie's Hair using the safety scissors.



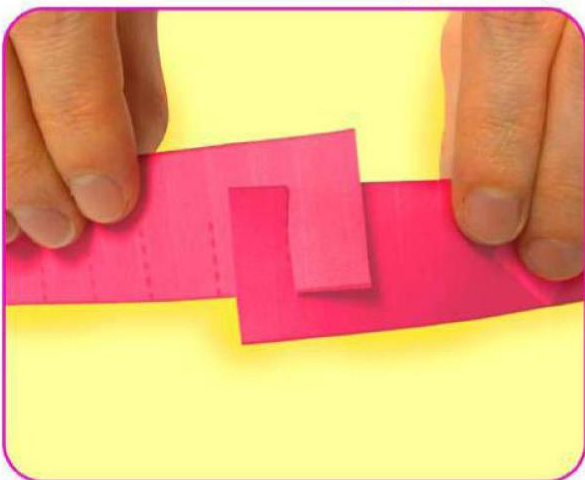
3. Cut out the two pink paper strips.



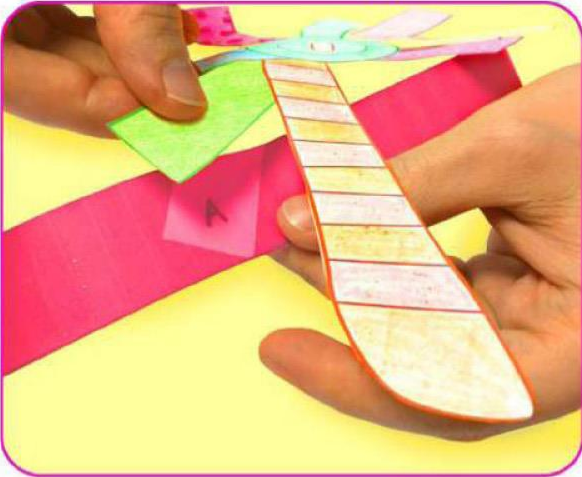
4. Cut the headband to size using the dotted lines as a guide.



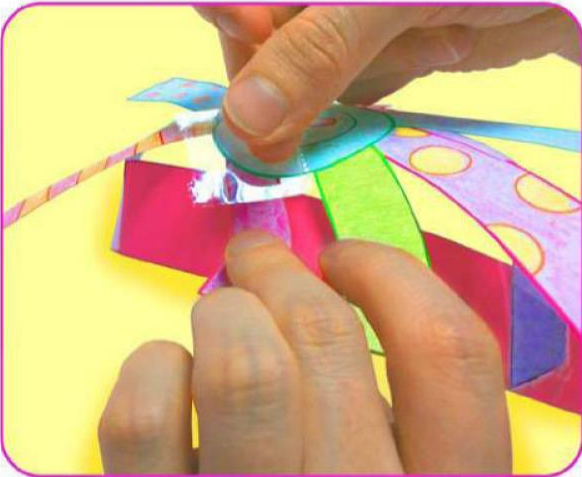
5. Slot the ends of the paper strips together and use sticky tape to secure.



6. Use sticky tape to secure strands A and B to the highlighted areas on the first paper strip.

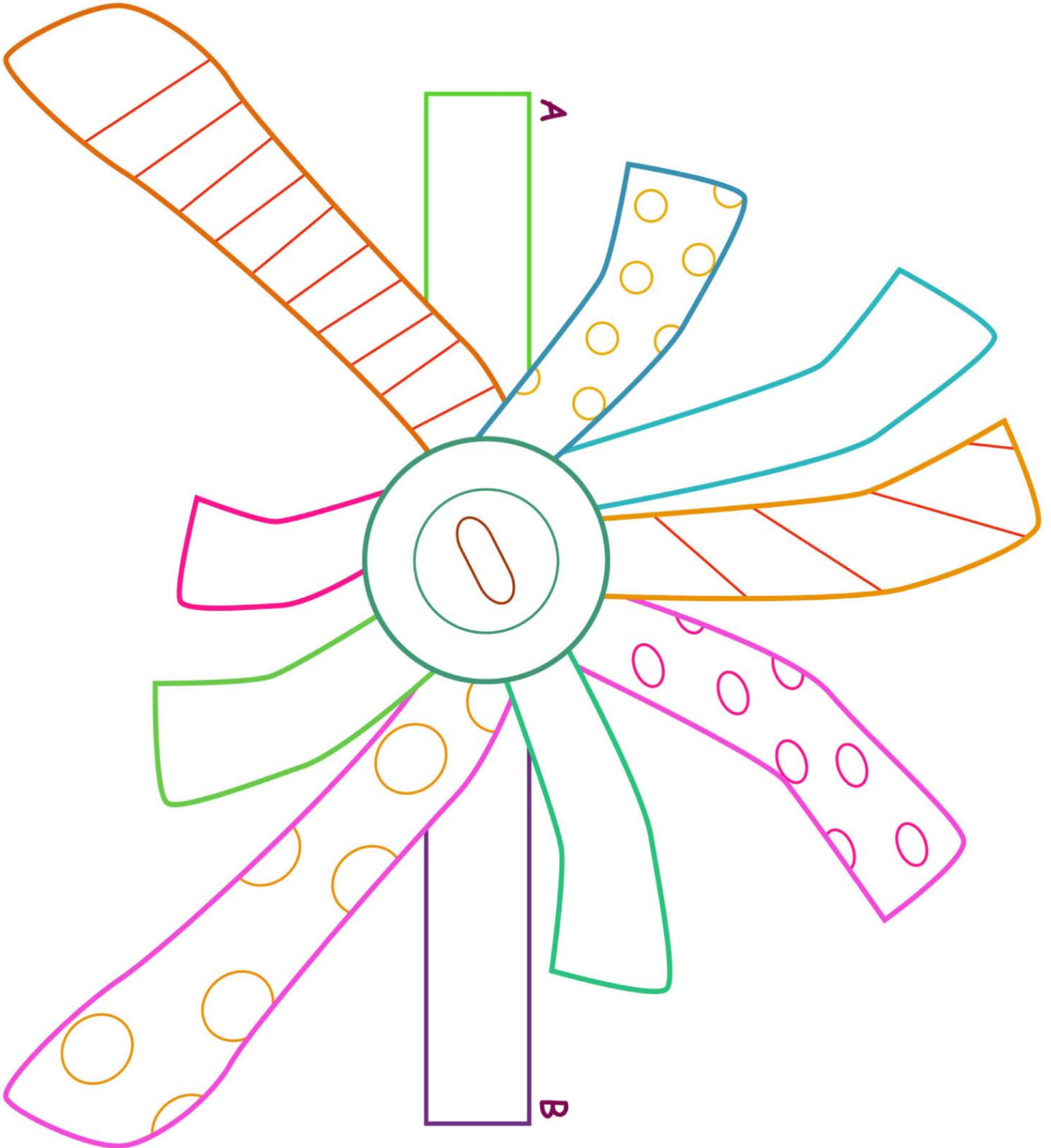


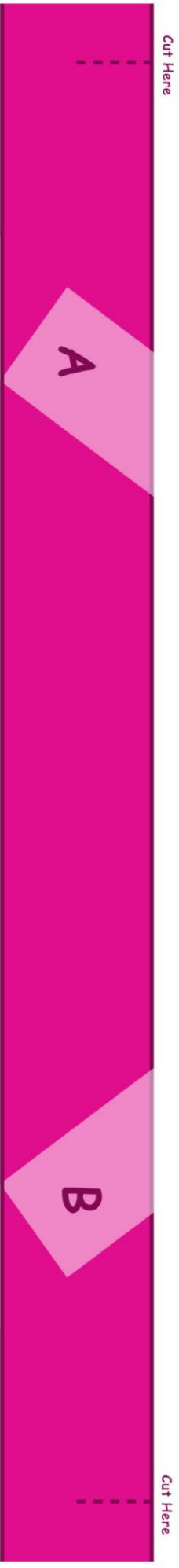
7. Tape the short front hair strand to the front of the headband.



**Now you can look just like Rosie!**








Once the other end of this strip has been connected, cut the line which is the closest to your child's head size
